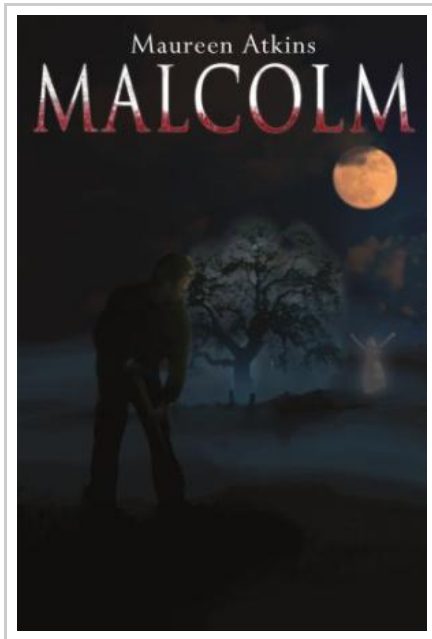




MALCOLM (Paperback)
