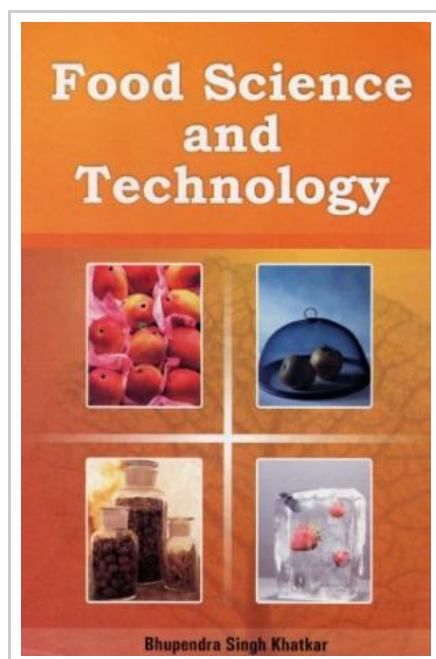




Food Science and Technology
