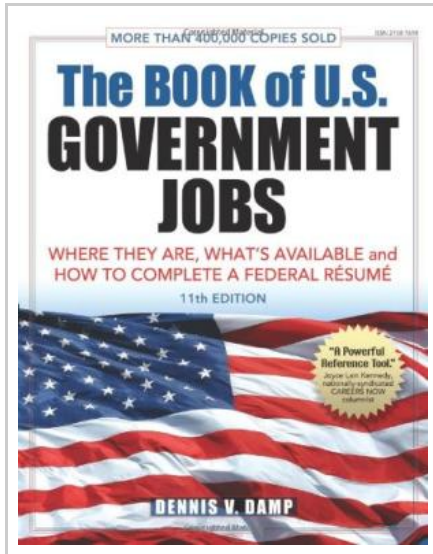




The Book of U.S. Government Jobs: Where They Are, Whats Available, How to Complete a Federal Resume
