As a well-traveled sea captain, he had gazed at them from many remote places in the world. After becoming a Christian, Bates studied astronomy in conjunction with the Bible, eventually publishing The Opening Heavens. In this tract, Bates reasoned that the biblical references to heaven being opened (John 1:51, Rev. 19:11) and to the New Jerusalem descending were referring to events that would occur in one location in the sky, the middle star of Orion s sword. Bates quoted astronomer Christiaan Huygens, who in 1656 had described the opening in the sky through which a brighter region was visible. For Bates, the region beyond must be the heaven of heavens streaming forth God's glory. Bates had read astronomer James Ferguson s descriptions of cloudy stars and how the most remarkable of all the cloudy stars is in Orion s sword, containing an opening into deeper space. He was convinced Huygens opening was the gateway to heaven. Later, Bates watched Ellen White in vision traveling to other planets...
