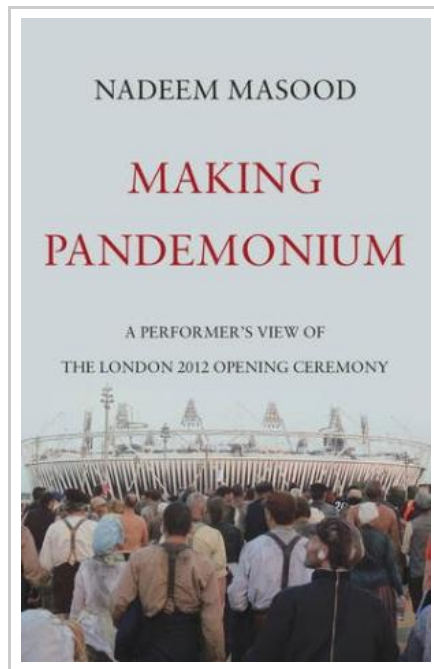




Making Pandemonium
