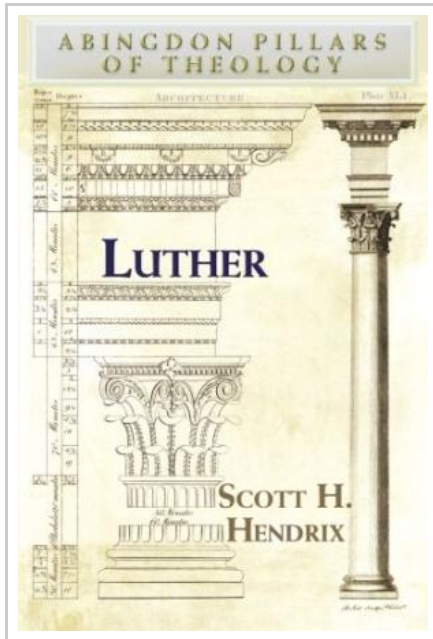




Luther (Paperback)
