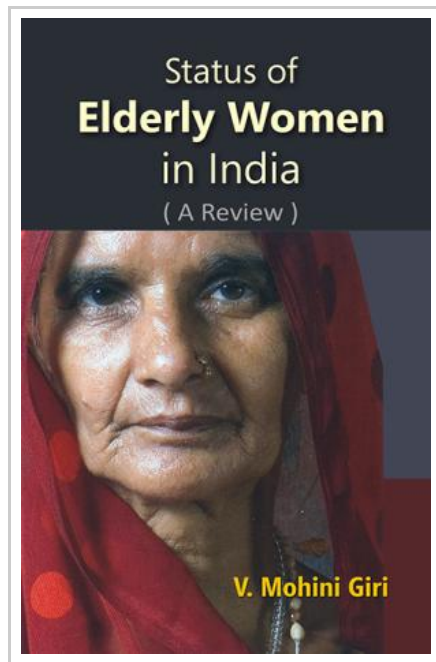




Status of Elderly Women In India (A Review)
