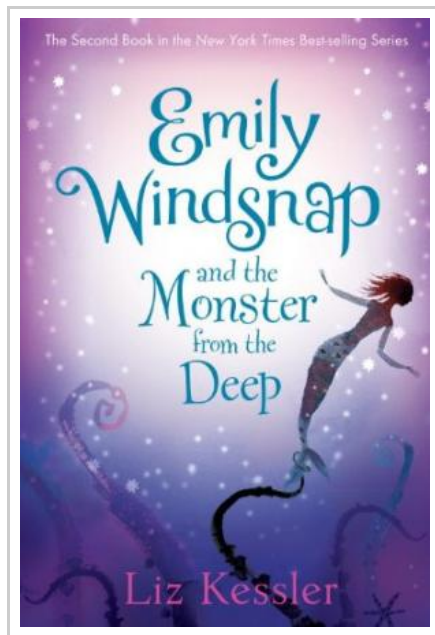




Emily Windsnap and the Monster from the Deep (Paperback)
